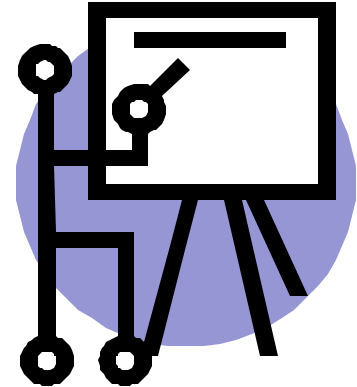
the completion of warranty registration, Numonics has established a new standard for quality and reliability of interactive whiteboard technology.

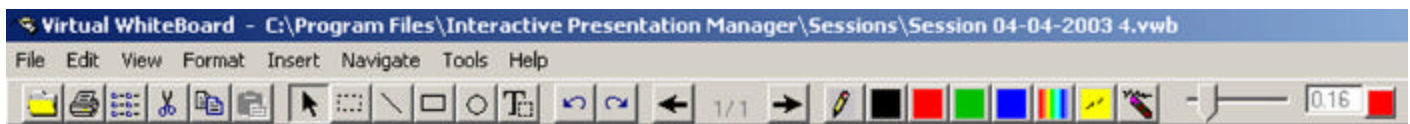

## IPM 7.0 Windows Software Release - Now Available!



The latest IPM software version 7.0 for Windows Operating Systems was released on April 9, 2003. There are many new exciting features, especially to the Virtual Whiteboard (VWB).

In this release, the user has the ability to enter text directly into Virtual Whiteboard, change the font, and make the text bold and/or italicized. Also, the toolbar has been reorganized for greater intuitiveness and to accommodate the introduction of three new

icon tools, such as a select object icon. Select an object with right mouse click and a dialogue box opens giving attributes that can be changed such as line width, color, font etc.

There is a new cursive background as well as pre-defined sports backgrounds and the ability for a user to input desired bitmap backgrounds into the pull down menu within Format/Options. These user-added backgrounds map to the full VWB screen and are rep-

licated on new pages if desired. A "Redo" function also has been added in VWB.

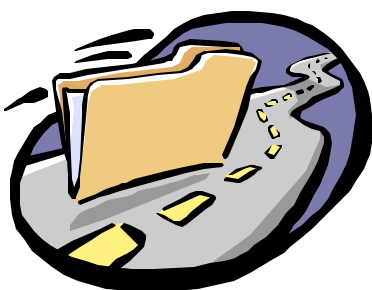
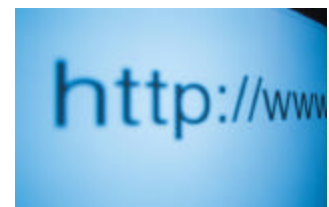
Regarding Softkeys, a third size small keyboard/keypad has been added. The <?> softkey now allows one-touch access to the Softkey Editor, Slide Show, View Snapshot files, On-Line Help and the Tutorial. Additional Windows Media Player file types will be available through the softkeys.

crease functionality while simplifying usage of the Interactive Presentation Manager.
