CPR Plan

Numonics customers can receive a “Conditional Pen Replacement” CPR via overnight carrier if their IPM/DPA multimedia pen fails for any reason. The customer should contact our Help Desk by phone stating the multimedia pen problem they are experiencing. Our Help Desk personnel will diagnose the problem and implement our “CPR” plan immediately upon determining a pen malfunction. The customer will be asked to complete an acknowledgement form tracking the new pen.

If the determination is made by 4:30 PM a “CPR” (along with a new charge cable) will be sent out by overnight carrier and a pre-paid return mailer will be included in the package. Upon receipt of the “CPR” the customer will return the malfunctioning pen in the pre-paid return mailer. The customer should be up and running within 24 hours experiencing a minimum of down time and inconvenience.

Take II—Multimedia Pen Purchase Plan

At the time of purchase a school may elect to purchase a second multimedia pen for the nominal cost of \$59.95 with a limit of two (2) additional pens per whiteboard. The additional pens may be corded or cordless at the school’s option.
